



## The 24-hour chronograph "Flying Officer" is back again !!!

This watch was originally developed in the 1960's by Guinand in Les Brenets (Swiss Jura Mountains) for pilots and navigators taking long-distance flights. At that time, it was equipped with calibre Valjoux 7733. To avoid confusion during flight it was created with a 24-hour display and set to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT). That guaranteed that the standard time used in international air traffic was always clearly recognizable.

This interesting chronograph will be available again in August 2007 in a high-quality true to original replica. A limited edition because the production of the base-calibre was stopped in recent years, the Flying Officer features a refined Valjoux 7760 manually wound movement, which has been carefully modified just for this watch.
